- I. **CALIBRATE** - To standardize; bring into conformity with a standard by determining the deviation so as to ascertain the proper correction factors needed to adjust precisely for a particular function
- II. **Process of Recalibration:**
 - A. **Standard** - Discover the standard
 - B. **Difference** - Determine the deviation
 - C. **Conformity** - Correct to conformity
- III. **Standard - Ps 19:7-11** - Discover the standard, basis, truth
 - A. **Standard** - Something established by authority, custom, or general consent as a model or example: a rule of measurement
 1. Restoration, Wisdom, Rejoicing, Purity, Enlightenment/Understanding, Endurance/Longevity, Truth & Justice, Wealth, Protection, Benefits & Rewards
 2. RECALIBRATING our lives in agreement with God means the Bible is our standard
 - a) **John 17:16-17** 16 They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. 17 Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth.
 3. **God's Word is THE STANDARD for BEST LIVING**
 - B. **Difference** - Determine the Deviation from the Standard
 1. **Ps 139:23-24** 23 Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me, and know my anxieties; 24 And see if there is any wicked way in me, And lead me in the way everlasting.
 2. **Ps 26:2** 2 Examine me, O Lord, and prove me; Try my mind and my heart.
 - a) **Prove** - *nacah* - To test
 3. **2 Cor 13:5** 5 Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Do you not know yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you? — unless indeed you are disqualified.
 - a) **Examine** - *peirazo* - Learn the nature or character of someone by submitting them to thorough and extensive testing
 - C. **Conformity** - Corrective actions - Make the proper corrections or adjustments necessary to conform with the standard.
