---

The purpose of the local church is not to ENTERTAIN people but to ENTER-TRAIN.

- To ENTER people into the fullness of Christ
- To TRAIN people as warrior disciples

It is NOT just are we coming to church, but are we BE-COMING the church as individuals.

---

## Luke 4: 1 NKJV

Then Jesus, being filled with the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness.

### **Filled — plērēs**

Complete; space completely occupied by something

---

## Acts 6: 3 NKJV

Therefore, brethren, seek out from among you seven men of good reputation, full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business.

---

## Romans 8: 11 NKJV

But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.

---

## Luke 4: 1 NKJV

Then Jesus, being filled with the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness.

### Led — agō

To bring, drive or carry; To direct or guide the movement of an object, without special regard to point of departure or goal

---

## Romans 8: 14 NKJV

For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.

---

## Luke 4: 14–15 NKJV

Then Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit to Galilee, and news of Him went out through all the surrounding region. And He taught in their synagogues, being glorified by all.

### Returned — hupōstrēphō

To go or come back to a place, condition, or activity where one has been before

In — Fixed position or Location

### Power — dunamis

Force, miraculous power, ability to perform an activity

### Glorified — dōxazō

To speak of something as being unusually fine and deserving honor—to praise

---

## Luke 4: 18 NKJV

“The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me,  
Because He has anointed Me  
To preach the gospel to the poor;  
He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted,  
To proclaim liberty to the captives  
And recovery of sight to the blind,  
To set at liberty those who are oppressed”

**Anointed — chriō**

To smear or rub, consecrate; assign or appoint to a task

**Gospel — ěuaggĕlizō**

To bring glad tidings or proclaim good news

**Sent — apōstĕllō**

To send out or away towards a goal or purpose

**Heal — iaōmai**

Make a person healthy again; to heal, make whole or well again

---

**John 6: 38 NKJV**

For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.

---

**Luke 4: 31–32 NKJV**

Then He went down to Capernaum, a city of Galilee, and was teaching them on the Sabbaths. And they were astonished at His teaching, for His word was with authority.

**Astonished — ěkplĕssō**

To be so amazed that you are overwhelmed; astounded, beside yourself, SHOOK

**Teaching — didaskō**

To impart skills or knowledge to; provide instruction, cause to learn

Jesus imparted skills for utilization not just knowledge for information

**Authority — ěxōusia**

Force, ability, jurisdiction, delegated influence. First the power or ability to do something then also the right and permission.

---

**Luke 4: 36 NKJV**

Then they were all amazed and spoke among themselves, saying, “What a word this is! For with authority and power He commands the unclean spirits, and they come out.”

**Authority — ěxōusia**

Force, ability, jurisdiction, delegated influence. First the power or ability to do something then also the right and permission.

**Power — dunamis**

Force, miraculous power, ability to perform an activity

**Commands — ěpitassō**

To order, instruct or direct what to do with authority. Right and jurisdiction to command

---

**Luke 9: 1 NKJV**

Then He called His twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases.

**Gave — didōmi**

Cause to have, distribute

**Power — dunamis**

Force, miraculous power, ability to perform an activity

**Authority — ěxousia**

Force, ability, jurisdiction, delegated influence. First the power or ability to do something then also the right and permission.

**To cure — thĕrapĕuō**

To provide care to improve and recover health

Same word used when Jesus “healed” in chapter 4

**Healed — thĕrapĕuō**

To provide care to improve and recover health

---

**Luke 9: 2 NKJV**

He sent them to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick.

**Sent — apōstĕllō**

To send out or away towards a goal or purpose

**Heal — iaōmai**

Make a person healthy again; to heal, make whole or well again

---

**Acts 5: 29 NKJV**

But Peter and the other apostles answered and said: “We ought to obey God rather than men.”

---

## Matthew 10: 7–8 NKJV

And as you go, preach, saying, 'The kingdom of heaven is at hand.' Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give.

### **Received — lambanō**

To take possession, grab, seize, accept; to receive or accept an object or benefit for which the initiative rests with the giver, but the focus of attention in the transfer is upon the receiver

### **Give — didōmi**

Cause to have, distribute

---

## Luke 9: 6 NKJV

So they departed and went through the towns, preaching the gospel and healing everywhere.

### **Gospel — ěuaggĕlizō**

To announce good news

### **Healing — thĕrapĕuō**

To provide care to improve and recover health

Same thing that Jesus did in Luke 4 with those who were sick with various diseases

---

## Luke 10: 1 NKJV

After these things the Lord appointed seventy others also, and sent them two by two before His face into every city and place where He Himself was about to go.

### **Appointed — anadĕiknumi**

To assign a duty; designate or give a task to

### **Others — hĕtĕrōs**

Different, not the same ones already mentioned before

### **Sent — apōstĕllō**

To send away towards a goal or purpose; send off

### **Heal — thĕrapĕuō**

To provide care to improve and recover health

---

## Luke 10: 2–9 NKJV

Then He said to them, “The harvest truly is great, but the laborers are few; therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest. Go your way; behold, I send you out as lambs among wolves. Carry neither money bag, knapsack, nor sandals; and greet no one along the road. But whatever house you enter, first say, ‘Peace to this house.’ And if a son of peace is there, your peace will rest on it; if not, it will return to you. And remain in the same house, eating and drinking such things as they give, for the laborer is worthy of his wages. Do not go from house to house. Whatever city you enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you. And heal the sick there, and say to them, ‘The kingdom of God has come near to you.’”

### **Heal — thērapēuō**

To provide care to improve and recover health

### **Authority — ěxōusia**

Force, ability, jurisdiction, delegated influence. First the power or ability to do something then also the right and permission.

### **Power — dunamis**

Force, miraculous power, ability to perform an activity

---

## Luke 10: 17–20 NKJV

Then the seventy returned with joy, saying, “Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name.” And He said to them, “I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you. Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rather rejoice because your names are written in heaven.”

---

## Matthew 28: 18–20 NKJV

And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, “All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.” Amen.

---

## Acts 1: 8 NKJV

But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”

---

## **Luke 24: 49 NIVUK**

I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high.

---

## **Matthew 25: 14–19 NKJV**

“For the kingdom of heaven is like a man traveling to a far country, who called his own servants and delivered his goods to them. And to one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one, to each according to his own ability; and immediately he went on a journey. Then he who had received the five talents went and traded with them, and made another five talents. And likewise he who had received two gained two more also. But he who had received one went and dug in the ground, and hid his lord’s money. After a long time the lord of those servants came and settled accounts with them.”

---

## **Romans 14: 11–12 NKJV**

For it is written: “As I live, says the LORD, Every knee shall bow to Me, And every tongue shall confess to God.” So then each of us shall give account of himself to God.

---

## **Matthew 24: 4–14 NKJV**

And Jesus answered and said to them: “Take heed that no one deceives you. For many will come in My name, saying, ‘I am the Christ,’ and will deceive many. And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not troubled; for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. And there will be famines, pestilences, and earthquakes in various places. All these are the beginning of sorrows. Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and kill you, and you will be hated by all nations for My name’s sake. And then many will be offended, will betray one another, and will hate one another. Then many false prophets will rise up and deceive many. And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold. But he who endures to the end shall be saved. And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.
