OVERVIEW

This week we learned something important:

Jesus was filled with the Holy Spirit.
Jesus was sent with power and authority.
Jesus gives His followers a job to do.
And one day, we will give an account for how we obeyed Him.

We are not filled with a feeling.
We are filled with God's Spirit.

That means we don't have to be afraid or weak.
We can listen, obey, and trust Him.

SECTION 1 — FILLED, NOT A FEELING

(Adult Guide: Section 1)

READ: Luke 4: 1, Romans 8: 11, Acts 1: 8

WHAT DO YOU THINK?

1. What happened to Jesus before He started His ministry?
If Jesus was filled and led by the Spirit, what does that show us about how we should live?
2. Who lives inside someone who follows Jesus?
If the same Spirit who raised Jesus from the dead lives in you, what does that mean about God's power in you?
3. What happens when the Holy Spirit comes upon believers?
If God gives power to help us be witnesses, what is that power for?

 **Big Idea:** God's Spirit lives in us to help us live boldly and tell others about Jesus.

SECTION 2 — SENT WITH AUTHORITY

(Adult Guide: Section 2)

READ: Luke 9: 1–2, Matthew 28: 18–20

WHAT DO YOU THINK?

1. What did Jesus give His disciples?
If Jesus gave them power and authority, were they supposed to be afraid or confident?
2. What did Jesus send them out to do?
What does that show us about what God’s Kingdom looks like?
3. Why does Jesus tell us to go and make disciples?
If all authority belongs to Jesus, what does that mean for people who follow Him?

 **Big Idea:** Jesus sends us out with His authority to help others and share the good news.

SECTION 3 — THE KINGDOM HAS COME NEAR

(Adult Guide: Section 3)

READ: Luke 10: 8–9, Luke 10: 17–20

WHAT DO YOU THINK?

1. Why did the disciples say, “The Kingdom of God has come near”?
What happens when someone who follows Jesus walks into a place?
2. What authority did Jesus say He gave them?
If Jesus gives authority over the enemy, should we be afraid of spiritual opposition?
3. What did Jesus say should make us happiest?
Is it more important to do powerful things, or to belong to Jesus?

 **Big Idea:** Our greatest joy is that we belong to Jesus — not just what we can do.

SECTION 4 — STAY FOCUSED ON THE MISSION

(Adult Guide: Section 4)

READ: Matthew 24: 4–14

WHAT DO YOU THINK?

1. What did Jesus warn would happen in the last days?
How could those things make people distracted or confused?
2. What must happen before the end comes?
What does that tell us about the Church’s main job?
3. What kinds of distractions could pull us away from sharing the gospel?
How can we stay focused on what matters most?

 **Big Idea:** Our job is to share the good news, not get distracted.

SECTION 5 — WE WILL GIVE AN ACCOUNT

(Adult Guide: Section 5)

READ: Matthew 25: 14–19, Romans 14: 11–12

WHAT DO YOU THINK?

1. What did the master do when he came back?
Why do you think he wanted to see what his servants had done?
2. Who will give an account to God?
What does that mean for how we live each day?
3. What has God given you (kindness, courage, gifts, opportunities)?
How can you use what God gave you this week?

 **Big Idea:** God gives us gifts and expects us to use them.

PRACTICE FOR THE WEEK

Live Filled, Sent, and Ready

STEP 1 — Ask

“Holy Spirit, where are You sending me this week?”

STEP 2 — Say

“I am filled with God’s Spirit. Jesus sends me. I can obey.”

STEP 3 — Do One Spirit-Led Thing


Listen first. Then obey.
