

OVERVIEW

This week, we are learning something amazing about Palm Sunday.

Palm Sunday was not just a story—it was part of God’s plan that He told hundreds of years before it happened!

God told His people when the Savior (Jesus) would come—and Jesus came at exactly the right time.

When Jesus rode into Jerusalem, it wasn’t random.

- 👉 It was the moment God sent His Lamb
- 👉 It was part of His perfect plan
- 👉 And many people didn’t recognize Him

This teaches us something important:
We don’t want to miss what God is doing.

God wants us to:

- Listen to His Word
 - Recognize Jesus
 - Be ready for His plan

MEMORY VERSE

“Take heed that no one deceives you.” — Mark 13:5

SECTION 1 — DO NOT BE DECEIVED

WHAT DOES “DECEIVED” MEAN?

It means being led the wrong way or believing something that isn't true.

BIG IDEA

God wants us to follow His truth, not just what people say.

READ

Mark 13:5, Matthew 16:21–23

TALK ABOUT IT

1. In Mark 13:5, what does Jesus tell us to be careful about?
2. Why did Peter not understand what Jesus was saying?
3. What does it mean to think like people instead of thinking like God?
4. Can someone be wrong even if they think they are right?
5. Why do we need God's Word to help us know truth?

THINK ABOUT IT

- What voices do I listen to the most?
- Do I go to God's Word first?
- How can I learn to listen to God more?

SECTION 2 — GOD'S PLAN (DANIEL 9)

WHAT IS GOD'S PLAN?

God has a plan for the world—and He knows exactly what He is doing.

BIG IDEA

God's Word is true, and His plan is perfect.

READ

Daniel 9:24–26

TALK ABOUT IT

1. What did God tell Daniel about the future?
2. Did God know when Jesus would come?

3. What does this show us about how powerful God is?
4. Can God's plans ever be wrong?
5. Why can we trust what God says?

THINK ABOUT IT

- Do I trust God's plan for my life?
 - Do I believe the Bible is true?
 - How does this help me trust God more?

SECTION 3 — PALM SUNDAY (THE LAMB)

WHAT HAPPENED ON PALM SUNDAY?

Jesus rode into Jerusalem—and God was sending His Lamb.

BIG IDEA

Jesus is the Lamb God sent to save us.

READ

Exodus 12:3–6, John 1:29, Luke 19:35–38

TALK ABOUT IT

1. What kind of lamb did God tell His people to choose in Exodus?
2. In John 1:29, what is Jesus called?
3. What happened when Jesus rode into Jerusalem?
4. Why is it important that Jesus came at the right time?
5. What does this show us about who Jesus is?

THINK ABOUT IT

- What does it mean that Jesus is the Lamb?
 - Why did God send Jesus for us?
 - How does this make me feel about Jesus?

SECTION 4 — DON'T MISS JESUS

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO MISS JESUS?

It means not recognizing what God is doing—even when it's right in front of you.

BIG IDEA

We want to recognize Jesus and respond to Him.

READ

John 5:39–40, Luke 19:41–44

TALK ABOUT IT

1. Why did some people not recognize Jesus?
2. Why was Jesus sad about Jerusalem?
3. Can someone know about God but still not follow Him?
4. How can we miss what God is doing today?
5. What should we do when God speaks to us?

THINK ABOUT IT

- Am I listening when God speaks to me?
 - Have I ever ignored something I knew was right?
 - What can I do to respond to Jesus?

SECTION 5 — BE READY

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE READY?

It means living for Jesus every day and being prepared for His return.

BIG IDEA

Jesus is coming again—so we live ready now.

READ

Mark 13:13, Matthew 28:19–20

TALK ABOUT IT

1. Who does Jesus say will be saved?
2. What mission did Jesus give us?
3. Who can tell others about Jesus?
4. Why is it important to live for Jesus now?
5. What does it mean to be ready for Jesus?

THINK ABOUT IT

- Am I living for Jesus every day?
 - Who can I tell about Jesus this week?
 - What is one way I can follow Him better?

PRACTICE FOR THE WEEK

 THIS WEEK'S FOCUS:

See Jesus. Welcome Him. Follow Him.

STEP 1 — SEE JESUS

 Read: Luke 19:35–38

 Pray:

“Jesus, help me see You clearly.”

“Help me recognize what You are doing.”

 Action:

- Pay attention to what God is showing you
 - Spend time reading your Bible this week
-

STEP 2 — WELCOME JESUS

 Read: John 1:29

 Pray:

“Jesus, I welcome You into my life and my day today.”

“Thank You for being the Lamb sent for me.”

 Action:

- Worship Jesus in your own words
 - Thank Him for loving you and saving you
-

STEP 3 — FOLLOW JESUS

 Read: Matthew 16:24

 Pray:

“Jesus, I want to follow You.”

“Help me obey You every day.”

 Action:

- Choose to obey God this week
 - Do what you know is right, even when it's hard
-

STEP 4 — LIVE READY

📖 Read: Mark 13:13

🙏 Pray:

“Jesus, help me be ready.”

“Help me live for You every day.”

🎯 Action:

- Make choices that honor God
 - Remember that Jesus is coming again
-
