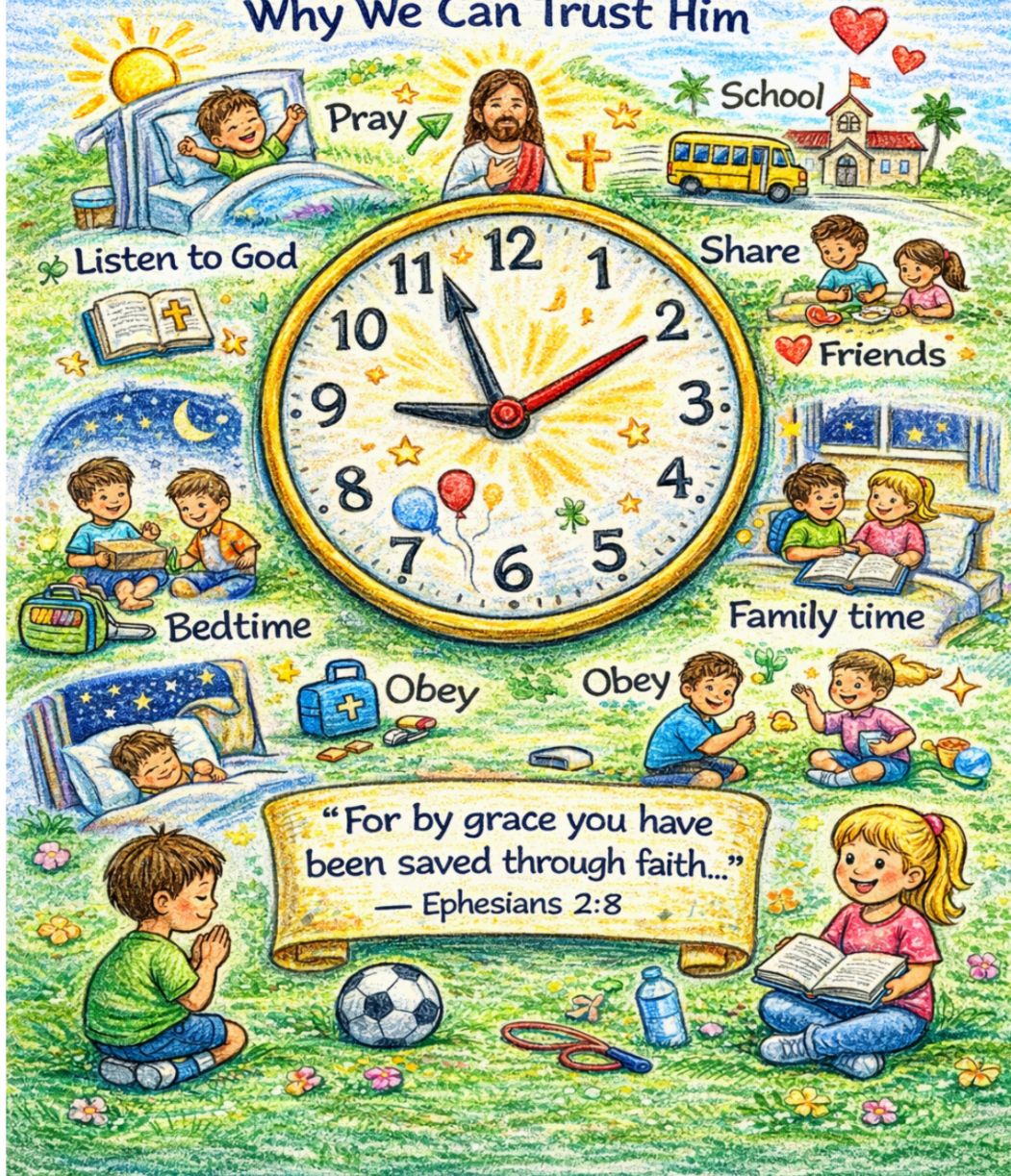

OVERVIEW

This week, we are learning something amazing about God and His Word.

A long time ago, God told Daniel exactly when Jesus (the Messiah) would come—and it happened exactly the way God said!

That means:

- 👉 God knows everything
- 👉 God’s timing is perfect
- 👉 And we can trust Him with our lives

This message also teaches us something very important:

Jesus didn’t come for Himself—He came for us.

And now we have a choice:

Will Jesus just be someone we learn about...
or will He be the Lord of our life?

God wants us to:

- Know His Word
 - Trust His plan
 - Follow Jesus
 - Be ready for what He is doing

 **MEMORY VERSE**

“For by grace you have been saved through faith...” — Ephesians 2:8

SECTION 1 — TRUST GOD’S WORD

 **WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?**

God’s Word is true, and we can trust it more than anything else.

BIG IDEA

We learn truth from God’s Word.

READ

Daniel 9:20–23, Mark 13:7–8

TALK ABOUT IT

1. What was Daniel doing when God sent an answer to him?
2. What does that show us about talking to God?
3. In Mark 13, what does Jesus say will happen in the world?
4. Why is it important to listen to Jesus instead of just people’s opinions?
5. How can we learn to listen to God’s Word more?

THINK ABOUT IT

- What voices do I listen to the most?
 - Do I go to God’s Word first?
 - How can I spend more time learning from the Bible?

SECTION 2 — GOD’S PLAN IS PERFECT

 **WHAT IS GOD’S PLAN?**

God knows what will happen before it happens.

BIG IDEA

God’s plan is always right and always on time.

READ

Daniel 9:24–25

TALK ABOUT IT

1. What did God tell Daniel about the future?
2. Where does the timeline start and end in these verses?
3. What does this show us about how powerful God is?
4. Can God ever be wrong about what will happen?
5. Why can we trust God's timing in our lives?

THINK ABOUT IT

- Do I trust God's timing?
 - Do I believe God knows what He is doing?
 - How can I trust Him more this week?

SECTION 3 — JESUS CAME AT THE RIGHT TIME

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

Jesus came exactly when God said He would.

BIG IDEA

God always keeps His promises.

READ

Daniel 9:25–26

TALK ABOUT IT

1. What was supposed to happen when the Messiah came?
2. What does this show us about God keeping His promises?
3. Why is it amazing that God knew this so long before it happened?
4. What does this teach us about how God controls history?
5. How does this help us trust God with our future?

THINK ABOUT IT

- Do I trust God with my future?
 - What promise from God can I hold onto?
 - How does this help me have faith?

SECTION 4 — JESUS DIED FOR US

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

Jesus didn't die for Himself—He died for us.

BIG IDEA

Jesus took our place.

READ

Daniel 9:26, 2 Corinthians 5:21, Ephesians 2:4–9

TALK ABOUT IT

1. What does it mean that the Messiah would be “cut off”?
2. Did Jesus die because He did something wrong?
3. What does the Bible say Jesus did for us in 2 Corinthians 5:21?
4. How does Ephesians 2 say we are saved?
5. Can we earn being right with God, or is it a gift?

THINK ABOUT IT

- Have I been trying to be “good enough” for God?
 - Do I understand that Jesus did this for me?
 - How does this make me feel about Jesus?

SECTION 5 — IS JESUS LORD?

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

Jesus is not just a teacher—He is Lord.

BIG IDEA

We choose to follow Jesus with our whole life.

READ

John 11:25–26, Matthew 7:21–23

TALK ABOUT IT

1. What does Jesus say about who He is in John 11?

2. What question does Jesus ask people to respond to?
3. What is the difference between knowing about Jesus and truly knowing Him?
4. What does it mean to let Jesus be in charge of your life?
5. How can you tell if someone is really following Jesus?

THINK ABOUT IT

- Is Jesus really in charge of my life?
 - Do I follow Him or just learn about Him?
 - What is one way I can obey Him this week?

SECTION 6 — BE READY

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE READY?

We live every day ready for Jesus.

BIG IDEA

Jesus is coming again, so we stay ready.

READ


Mark 13:33–37

TALK ABOUT IT

1. What does Jesus tell us to do while we wait?
2. How should we live while we are waiting for Him?
3. What is the difference between being ready and being scared?
4. How does reading the Bible help us stay ready?
5. What does a life that is ready for Jesus look like?


THINK ABOUT IT

- Am I living ready for Jesus?
 - What would I change if I knew He was coming soon?
 - What is one thing I can do this week to follow Him better?

 **THIS WEEK'S FOCUS:** Trust God. Follow Jesus. Be Ready.

STEP 1 — TRUST GOD

 Read: Daniel 9:25

 Pray: “God, help me trust Your plan.”

 Action:

- Read your Bible this week
 - Remember that God knows everything
-

STEP 2 — THANK JESUS

 Read: 2 Corinthians 5:21

 Pray: “Jesus, thank You for taking my place.”

 Action:

- Thank Jesus for loving you
 - Talk to Him in your own words
-

STEP 3 — FOLLOW JESUS

 Read: John 11:25


 Pray: “Jesus, I want You to be Lord of my life.”

 Action:

- Obey what God shows you
 - Choose what is right
-

STEP 4 — BE READY

 Read: Mark 13:33

 Pray: “Jesus, help me be ready.”

 Action:

- Live for Jesus every day
 - Make choices that honor Him
-

REMEMBER

God said Jesus would come—and He did. God keeps His promises.

Jesus came for you. And He is coming again.

This week, we choose to:

👉 Trust God, Follow Jesus & Be ready.
