- A. Theme Initiation is more powerful than prevention
- B. Two Things every soldier/believer needs to understand:
 - 1. Mission Direction
 - 2. Rules of Engagement Authority Eph 6:10-13
- C. Mission Make disciples of all nations Disciple nations! (people)
 - 1. **<u>MISSION</u>**: As you go, into the seven mountains of influence in society, influence culture with the kingdom of heaven under the authority of Jesus.

D. Seven Mountains of influence in culture:

- 1. Arts & Entertainment/Sports
- 2. Economy
- 3. Education
- 4. Family
- 5. Government
- 6. Media/Communications
- 7. Religion

E. Blue-print worldview vs. Warfare worldview

- 1. **Sovereign** Webster's 1828 Dictionary Supreme in power to all others; one who possesses the highest authority without control.
 - a) Gal 5:22-23 NKJV Fruits of the Spirit Self-control
 - (1) Self-control ĕgkratĕia To exercise control over one's desires and actions
 - b) Eph 1:11 NKJV who works all things according to the counsel of His will
 - c) Dan 4:35 NKJV He does according to His will... No one can restrain His hand
 - d) **Ps 115:3 NKJV** 3 But our God is in heaven; He does whatever He pleases.
 - e) Ps 135:6 NKJV 6 Whatever the Lord pleases He does, In heaven and in earth
- 2. Transformation is not so much about what we prevent but what we initiate!

II. How do we bring transformation? - Baptizing into something

- A. **<u>Baptizing</u>** Present/active tense verb The verb tense where the writer portrays an action in process or a state of being with no assessment of the action's completion
- B. **<u>Baptizing</u>** *baptizō* To make whelmed; cover wholly, flood; immersed; plunge, engage deeply
 - 1. <u>2 Cor 13:14</u> *NKJV* 14 The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all. Amen.

C. Baptizing or Immersing In the <u>NAME</u> of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit

1. Father:

- a) Lack Jehovah-Jireh The LORD who provides
- b) Sickness Jehovah-Rapha The LORD who heals
- c) Fear and anxiety Jehovah-Shalom The LORD is PEACE

2. <u>Jesus</u>:

- a) Sin Savior and my Redeemer
- b) Loneliness Immanuel God with us
- c) Betrayal and deception Faithful and True

3. Holy Spirit:

- a) Confusion Guide
- b) Sadness or despair Comforter
- c) Difficulty Helper
