A. <u>V35</u> -

- 1. <u>Cast away</u> apoballo To throw off or away; To remove a piece of clothing quickly and throw aside
- 2. <u>Confidence</u> parrhesia
 - a) Pas All, every, totality of something
 - b) rheo To utter, speak or say; flow like water
 - c) parrhesia Continue to speak openly and freely, unreservedness in speaking; To speak boldly
- 3. Reward misthapodosia A payment of wages or reward of what is earned good or bad.

B. V36 -

- 1. <u>Endurance</u> hupomone Cheerful endurance, constancy; ability to maintain under difficult circumstances.
 - a) Phil 1:28 AMP 28 And do not [for a moment] be frightened or intimidated in anything by your opponents and adversaries, for such [constancy and fearlessness] will be a clear sign (proof and seal) to them of [their impending] destruction, but [a sure token and evidence] of your deliverance and salvation, and that from God.
- 2. After you have done poieo To do, produce results that will satisfy someone.
- 3. You may receive komizo To carry off; to experience in return for something.
- 4. <u>Promise</u> epaggelia To pronounce upon, declare; Something that was promised to someone, agreement

C. V38 -

- 1. Just dikaios Right, pertaining to being in a right relationship with God
- 2. <u>Live</u> zao To live, behave or conduct oneself with the manner specified by the context.
- 3. <u>Faith</u> pistis To be persuaded, convinced or certain of something so that your actions correspond

- 4. <u>Draws back</u> hupostello To shrink back, be timid, to cease or stop doing something of positive value because of adverse circumstances or fear; give up.
- 5. <u>No pleasure</u> eudokeo To be pleased with or take pleasure in something; think that it is good or preferable.

D. V39 -

- 1. <u>Draw back</u> hupostello To shrink back, be timid, to cease or stop doing something of positive value because of adverse circumstances or fear; give up.
- 2. <u>Perdition</u> apoleia Actions demonstrating complete waste for the value of something; waste or ruin
- 3. <u>Believe</u> pistis To be persuaded, convinced or certain of something so that your actions correspond.
- 4. <u>Saving</u> peripoiesis The experience of an event or state which has been acquired. Acquisition, possession and preservation
- 5. <u>V39 RMT</u> We are not "of those" who through fear or timidity shrink back and stop going after something and ruin or waste what Jesus died to give us but we are convinced and persuaded to take the actions necessary to take possession, experience and preserve everything that Jesus acquired for us in this life and in eternity!
