A. **V23** -

- 1. WHAT Do poieo To make or do; produce results, construct, build
- 2. **HOW Do** *ergazomai* to work, engage in an activity involving considerable effort and labor.
 - a) Prov 12:24 24 The hand of the diligent will rule, But the lazy man will be put to forced labor.
 - b) **Prov 13:4** 4 The soul of a lazy man desires, and has nothing; But the soul of the diligent shall be made rich.
 - c) <u>Prov 21:5</u> NLT 5 Good planning and hard work lead to prosperity, but hasty shortcuts lead to poverty.
 - d) Heartily ek Out of or originating from; psuche breath, spirit
- 3. WHERE To the LORD and not to men Who is it "to"?
 - a) <u>**V22**</u> -
 - (1) <u>Eyeservice</u> ophthalmodouleia slave to the eye, needs watching; to serve with a view to impress others or call attention to oneself.

 - (b) douleia slavery, to be a slave to
 - b) **Prov 29:26** 26 Many seek the ruler's favor, But justice for man comes from the Lord.

1. **Knowing** - *eido* - To understand or comprehend

- 2. Receive apolambano To receive from someone what is due
- 3. **Reward** antapodosis What is given in exchange for what has been done.
- 4. **Inheritance** *kleronomia* Valuable possession received upon the death of the benefactor.
 - a) <u>Heb 11:6</u> 6 But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him

A. Joseph - Gen 39:1-5 -

- 1. Successful tsalach Push forward, make progress, prosper
- 2. **Prosper in his hand** Doing something, working
 - a) <u>Eccl 9:10</u> 10 Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with your might; for there is no work or device or knowledge or wisdom in the grave where you are going.
- 3. Favor chen To bend or stoop kindness, mercy or generosity to an inferior
 - a) <u>Prov 3:3-4</u> 3 Let not mercy and truth forsake you; Bind them around your neck, Write them on the tablet of your heart, 4 And so find favor and high esteem In the sight of God and man.
 - b) <u>Luke 2:52</u> 52 And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men.

- 1. **<u>Distinguished</u>** *netsach* To glitter from afar, to stand out above the rest.
