I. WE GO LOW - HUMBLE

A. <u>1 Peter 5:1-7</u>

- 1. Lords katakurieuo To master or lord down upon; To overpower; control
- 2. **Examples** tupos a visual form designed to be imitated or copied; model, pattern
- 3. Submit hupotasso To arrange under; to bring under; Go under and support, lift up
- 4. Humility tapeinophrosune humbleness or lowliness of mind
 - a) <u>Phil 2:3-4</u> 3 Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in <u>lowliness</u> of mind let each esteem others better than himself. 4 Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others
 - (1) Not a position of inferiority but about priority
- 5. <u>Clothed</u> *egkomboomai* To dress oneself, make something one's own, clothing that is fastened or girded on.
- 6. Resists the Proud
 - a) Proud huperephanos Arrogant, haughty, contemptuous
 - (1) huper Over, above
 - (2) phaino To shine or lighten only the superficial but not real character.
 - b) Resists antitassomai To arrange opposite; to oppose; both in attitude and behavior
 - (1) He stands on the other side, He offers resistance to.
- 7. Gives grace to the humble
 - a) Humble tapeinos To depress, make low,
 - b) Grace charis Favorable attitude towards someone; favor, goodwill
 - (1) **Prov 3:34** 34 Surely He scorns the scornful, But gives grace to the humble.
 - (2) <u>Matt 7:1-2</u> 1 "Judge not, that you be not judged. 2 For with what judgment you judge, you will be judged; and with the measure you use, it will be measured back to you.

B. V6 - Humble Yourselves - You GO low

- 1. Under the "mighty hand of God" Hupo
 - a) False Humility -
 - (1) Pride is when we say that we ARE something that we AREN'T

- (2) False Humility is when we say that we are NOT something that we ARE.
- b) <u>Prov 15:33</u> 33 The fear of the Lord is the instruction of wisdom, And before honor is humility.
- c) **Prov 22:4** 4 By humility and the fear of the Lord Are riches and honor and life.

2. He may exalt you in due time -

- a) **<u>Exalt</u>** *hupsoo* To elevate; cause someone to have a high status or position.
 - (1) <u>Matt 23:12</u> 12 And whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted.
 - (2) James 4:10 10 Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He will lift you up.
 - (3) <u>Col 3:1</u> 1 If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God.
- b) Due time kairos An occasion, set, proper or opportune time
