- a) _____ **Gate**
 - (1) **Heb 9:22** 22 And according to the law almost all things are purified with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no remission
 - (2) **John 1:29** 29 The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!"
 - (3) **Heb 10:19-21** 19 Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, 20 by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, 21 and having a High Priest over the house of God
 - (a) The high priest Eliashib (God restores) built the Sheep Gate and set up its doors

- (b) Jesus (Yeshua - Salvation) is our High Priest of New Covenant, who made a way (gate, door) for us.
- (4) **John 10:9** 9 I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved,
 - (5) **John 14:6** 6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.
 - (6) **Rev 1:8** 8 "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End," says the Lord, "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty."
 - (7) Stays unlocked - **John 3:16** 16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.
- b) _____ **Gate** - Merchants used this gate to bring in fish they caught to be sold.
- (1) **Matt 4:19-20** 19 Then He said to them, "Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men." 20 They immediately left their nets and followed Him
 - (2) **Two essential applications of the Fish Gate:**
 - (a) **Telling others about Him** - Evangelism - called to be fishers of men.
 - (b) **Serving His Kingdom** - left "their" nets and "followed Him".
 - i) **Luke 10:2** 2.. "The harvest truly is great, but the laborers are few; therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.
 - (3) **Bring in the catch - Harvest**
 - (4) **Luke 14:23** 23 Then the master said to the servant, 'Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel them to come in, that my house may be filled.
