- I. <u>Difference</u> Something that makes two or more persons or things not the same.
 - A. Holy Spirit will make a difference in your:
 - 1. POSITION
 - 2. POWER
 - 3. PATIENCE

II. Gen 41 - Joseph - Position

- A. "God is not leading me into situations that I can handle, He is leading me into situations where I can lean."
 - 1. <u>1 Cor 10:13</u> Not tempted beyond what you are able...
- B. Spirit of God brought Promotion Position Influence
 - 1. God has a kingdom purpose attached to your position!
- C. God can change your position quickly (suddenly)
 - 1. <u>Isa 48:3</u> 3 I have declared the former things from the beginning; They went forth from My mouth, and I caused them to hear it. <u>Suddenly</u> I did them, and they came to pass.
- D. <u>Ex 31:1-5 Bezalel</u> <u>Position</u>
 - 1. <u>Ex 31:1-5</u> 3 And I have filled him with the Spirit of God, in wisdom, in understanding, in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship...
- E. Holy Spirit makes a difference in your POSITION!

III. Judges 14:5-6 - Samson - Power

- A. <u>V6</u> <u>Mightily</u> *tsalach* To push forward, break out, succeed, progress, be profitable
 - 1. Tore a lion apart like one would a young goat.
 - a) Nothing in his hand No sword Not by natural means but supernatural
 - 2. Power/Strength to do things you couldn't do on your own
 - 3. <u>Isa 40:29-31</u> 29 He gives power to the weak, And to those who have no might He increases strength.
 - 4. **Eph 6:10** 10 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might.
- B. <u>V19</u> Killed 30 men (Enemies)
 - 1. Outnumbered 30-1 Holy Spirit evens the odds!
- C. <u>Judges 15:14-15</u> Fire of the Holy Spirit
 - 1. Fire of the Holy Spirit brings freedom from enemies
 - 2. <u>Deut 9:3</u> the Lord your God is He who goes over before you as a *consuming fire*.

IV. <u>1 Sam 16:11-14 - David</u> - Patience

- A. Spirit of the LORD came upon from that "day forward" Speaks to process, journey
 - 1. **Phil 3:13-14** 13 Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, 14 I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.
 - 2. It takes patience Patience (longsuffering) is a fruit of the Holy Spirit
 - a) <u>Heb 6:11-12</u> 11 And we desire that each one of you show the same diligence to the full assurance of hope until the end, 12 that you do not become sluggish, but imitate those who through faith and patience inherit the promises.
 - b) <u>Patience</u> *makrothumia* A state of emotional calm in the face of adversity without complaint, constancy, perseverance.
