#### I. Gen 11:1 - Power of Communication

- A. <u>V6</u> -
  - 1. <u>One</u> *echad* United; to be joined together into one whole.
  - 2. <u>Mark 10:7-9</u> 7 'For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, 8 and the two shall become one flesh'; so then they are no longer two, but one flesh.
  - 3. **Language** *Webster* the system of words or signs that people use to express thoughts and feelings to each other.
  - 4. <u>Begin</u> *chalal* An opening wedge; Believe in the process.
  - 5. **<u>Propose</u>** *zamam* To plan, plot or imagine;
    - a) **Imagine** to form a picture, idea or opinion in your mind of something not a reality or currently present.
    - b) <u>**Heb 11:1**</u> 1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.
  - 6. <u>Withheld</u> *batsar* Inaccessible, out of their reach

- A. Jer 1:9-10 9 Then the Lord put forth His hand and touched my mouth, and the Lord said to me: "Behold, I have put <u>My</u> words in your mouth. 10 See, I have this day set you over the nations and over the kingdoms, To root out and to pull down, To destroy and to throw down, To build and to plant."
- B. James 1:19 19 So then, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath; 20 for the wrath of man does not produce the righteousness of God.

#### III. Communication Styles or Methods

- A. <u>Passive Communication</u> You matter, I don't;
  - 1. This person uses this form of communication seems to have no needs and is the eternal long-sufferer.
- B. <u>Aggressive Communication</u> I matter. You don't; what I think matters and what you think doesn't.
  - Fear and love are mortal enemies <u>1 John 4:18</u> 18 There is <u>no fear in love</u>; <u>but perfect love casts out</u> <u>fear</u>, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love
- C. <u>Passive Aggressive</u> You matter.....NOT!
  - 1. They have all the "right answers" but have heart issues.
    - a) Mark 7:6 6...This people honors Me with their lips, But their heart is far from Me.
- D. <u>Assertive Communication</u> You matter, and so do I.

## IV. Effective Conflict Communication - Resolving conflict is a process

- A. <u>Eph 4:29</u> 29 Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers.
  - 1. <u>**Corrupt**</u> *sapros* worthless, no value; rotten, low quality.
  - 2. <u>**Proceed**</u> *ekporeuomai* discharge, depart or travel out from. Come out.
  - 3. <u>Edification</u> *oikodome* The process of building
    - a) Building building involves a gradual process of developing something by putting different materials together to make a finished product

# V. Levels of Communication

- A. <u>Cliche</u> Surface level, greetings w/ absolute strangers and require zero communication skills or relationship.
- B. Facts Non-emotional Facts about the kids, activities, schedules, etc.
- C. **<u>Opinions/Ideas/Perspectives</u>** Express your position; Two people actually show up.

# 1. The goal of communication cannot be agreement but understanding.

- D. Feelings Intimacy and vulnerability
  - 1. "I" Messages A tool that lets you see me instead of trying to convince you that you are wrong.
  - 2. If you can put the word "think" in the sentence and it makes sense then it's not a feeling.

- a) **Addiction** An attempt to create intimacy through a relationship with an object.
