I. 2 Cor 4:16-18 - Inner Man vs. Outer Man

- A. **Perishing** *diaphtheiro* Gradually waste away or decay
- B. <u>Being Renewed</u> to renovate (restore life, vigor or activity, to a better state); to cause to grow up new, to make new; new strength, new in nature, different from the usual, impressive, better than the old, superior in value or attraction
 - 1. <u>Bill Johnson</u>: "Both hope and hopelessness are contagious, decide what kind of influence you want to have on the world around you."
- **C.** What is your "yet" for your "even though"?

II. 2 Cor 4:17

- A. <u>Light affliction for a moment</u> Outer man and temporary
 - 1. <u>Affliction</u> *thlipsis* Pressure, oppression, stress, anguish, tribulation, adversity, affliction, crushing, squashing, squeezing, distress. Outer Man
 - 2. **Moment** = Time which is temporary
 - **3. Eternal weight of glory** Inner Man and eternal, far more exceeding!
- **B.** <u>John 16:33</u> 33 These things I have spoken to you, that <u>in Me</u> you may have <u>peace</u>. In the world you will have **tribulation**; but be of good cheer, <u>I have overcome the world</u>.
 - 1. <u>Tribulation</u> Pressure, oppression, stress, anguish, tribulation, adversity, affliction, crushing, squashing, squeezing, distress.
 - a) In Me=Peace; In World=Pressure, stress, affliction, adversity, distress
 - 2. <u>Overcome</u> *nikao* (*nike*) To win a victory over, conquer or be victorious
