## I. Luke 12:49-53

A. Kindled - anaptō - Ignite, start a fire, begin to burn

1. Luke 12:49 (TPT) 49 "I have come to set the earth on fire. And how I long for every heart to be already ablaze with this fiery passion for God!
2. Matthew 3:11 (NKJV) 11 I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.
B. Baptism - baptisma - Plunged entirely into a difficult event, to be overwhelmed by a difficult experience or ordeal.
C. Distressed - suněchō-To hold together; To experience great psychological pressure and anxiety, to be troubled, afflicted with anxious uneasiness or grief
D. Accomplished - tëlēō - The end, complete, execute, conclude
3. Hebrews 12:2 (NKJV) 2 looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
E. Peace - ěirēnē - Harmonious relations and freedom from disputes
4. John 14:27 (NKJV) 27 Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.
5. John 14:16-17 (NKJV) 16 And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever- 17 the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you.
6. Luke 2:14 (NKJV) 14 "Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace, goodwill toward men!"
F. Division - diaměrismŏs - To partition or divide thoroughly into opposing groups; disunion (of opinion and conduct)
G. Jesus said that He was going to be POLARIZING!!
7. Polarizing - Causing strong disagreement between opposing factions or groupings
8. Bigoted - 1) blindly devoted to some creed, opinion, or practice; 2) having or showing an attitude of hatred or intolerance toward the members of a particular group (such as a racial or ethnic group)
II. Matthew 10:34-39
A. Denies - arněŏmai - To refuse to recognize or acknowledge
B. Sword - machaira - Discord or war
9. 1 John 3:7-8 (NKJV) 7 Little children, let no one deceive you. He who practices righteousness is righteous, just as He is righteous. 8 He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.

A. Deny - aparněŏmai - To refuse to recognize or acknowledge

C. Cross - staurǒs - To be prepared to endure severe suffering, even to the point of death
