    disciple of someone, in the sense of adhering to the teachings or instructions
    of a leader and promoting the cause of that leader.
  - 2. **Nations** ethnos race, ethnic group; diversity
- B. **V20** How do we make disciples of all the nations?
  - 1. **Teaching** *didasko* To provide instruction
  - 2. Observe tereo To guard, cause to stay or continue or retain
  - 3. <u>Commanded</u> *entellomai* To give definite orders, implying authority or official sanction.

- Franklin D. Roosevelt 32nd President of the United States Democratic Party
- Andrew Jackson 7th President Democratic-Republican party and Democratic Party

- 5. **Zachary Taylor** 12th President Whig Party
- Benjamin Franklin 250 founding fathers, one of the 5 least religious. 1754
   One of the first to call for the United States of America instead of 13 colonies.
- III. One Nation, Under God, Indivisible A Nation "Under God" can be indivisible.
  - A. <u>Indivisible</u> "Impossible" to divide or separate: not divisible
    - 1. God is love Stay under love, we will be indivisible
    - 2. Rom 8:35-39
    - 3. <u>Eph 4:1-3</u> 1 I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called, 2 with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, 3 endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.
      - a) <u>Bearing with</u> *anechomai* to be patient with, in the sense of enduring possible difficulty. To accept or receive.
      - b) **Endeavoring** *spoudazo* Speed, Make prompt effort, hurry to do with intense effort.
      - c) Unity henotes oneness
      - d) **Bond** sundesmos Something that binds or ties together.
      - e) Peace eirene Freedom from anxiety and inner turmoil.
