 - 1. Consecrate qâdôsh To be set apart; holy, sacred, dedicated
 - a) Philippians 3:7–8
 - (1) Gain kĕrdŏs Advantage or profitable
 - (2) Loss zēmia Detriment, disadvantage, damage
 - (3) Rubbish skubalŏn Worthless, unwanted material, garbage, dung
 - 2. <u>James 4:4 (NKJV)</u> Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.
 - a) Friendship philia Love, affection, fondness for, friendship with
 - b) Enmity ĕchthra Hostility, opposition, hatred
 - 3. **2 Cor 6:14-18; 7:1**
 - a) <u>Unequally yoked together</u> hětěrŏzugěō Wrongly matched in association
 - b) Fellowship mětochē Partnership involving shared purposes and activity
 - c) Righteousness dikaiŏsunē What is right in God's eyes, justice, to be put right with God
 - d) Lawlessness anŏmia Illegality, violation of law or wickedness
 - e) <u>Communion</u> *kŏinōnia* Intimate association, close mutual relations or involvement
 - f) **<u>Dwell</u>** *ĕnŏikĕō* Inhabit, live in or reside in

- g) <u>Separate</u> aphŏrizō To set off by boundary; limit, set apart for a particular task or function
- h) Unclean akathartos Tainted with impurities; impure in the eyes of God
- 4. **Ephesians 5:8–11**
 - a) **Fellowship** *sugkŏinōnĕō* To co-participate in, be partaker of; partner with, take part together
