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## l. <u>Ex 29:42-46</u>

### A. <u>V42</u> - At the door of the tabernacle of meeting

- 1. <u>**Door**</u> *pethach* The opening, portal or entrance way in and out of a space; where you enter or leave an area; figuratively; the means
  - a) John 10:6-10 Jesus said, "I am the door..."
  - b) John 3:3–6 Born again to see the kingdom
- 2. Tabernacle of meeting
  - a) **Revelation 21:3** The tabernacle of God is with men
  - b) **<u>1 Corinthians 6:19–20</u>** Your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit
  - c) John 14:17 He dwells with you and will be in you.

#### 3. I will meet you to speak with you

- a) Meet Iô' To, towards, to the point; toward a goal
- b) John 6:63 The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life.
- c) Jeremiah 33:3 God will answer us and show us great things
  - (1) Mighty bâtsar Inaccessible, isolated, out of reach
- d) **<u>1 Corinthians 2:9–10</u>** God has revealed them to us through His Spirit
- e) John 16:13–15 He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you
- B. V43 Sanctified by My glory
  - <u>Glory</u> kâbôd Weight; splendor, honor, majesty, abundance, manifestation of presence and power
    - a) **<u>Colossians 1:27</u>** Christ in you, the hope of glory.
  - 2. <u>Titus 3:5–7</u> Not by works of righteousness which we have done
  - 3. **Ephesians 2:8–9** For by grace you have been saved through faith
  - 4. Sanctified qâdôsh Sacred; set apart, dedicated to service and loyalty to God

## C. <u>V44-46</u> - Consecrate Aaron and his sons

- 1. Consecrate qâdôsh To be set apart; holy, sacred, dedicated
- 2. **<u>Dwell</u>** *shâkan* To inhabit, live in, abide or rest in; remain, camp, make a home
- Know yâda Reveal; Cause something to be known through instruction and experience
- 4. <u>2 Corinthians 6:14–18</u> Do not be unequally yoked together
  - a) **Unequally yoked together** *hětěrŏzugěō* Mismatched, different in kind, size, effort or direction
  - b) <u>Separate</u> aphŏrizō To set off or apart from something for the purpose of something else; excluded and appointed
  - c) Unclean akathartŏs Impure, defiled in the eyes of God
  - d) Receive ĕisdĕchŏmai To welcome into one's presence or home
    - (1) James 4:4 Friendship with the world is enmity with God
    - (2) Matthew 5:10 Persecuted for righteousness 'sake
    - (3) **<u>1 Peter 3:14–15</u>** Suffer for righteousness 'sake, you are blessed
