

I. Ex 29:42-46

A. 5 Phases of Dwelling with God:

1. Enter - The Door
2. Engage - The Meeting
3. Encounter - The Glory
4. Evacuate - The Consecrating
5. Endure - The Dwelling

B. V42 - Phase 1 - Enter - The Door

1. John 10:9 (NKJV) Jesus said, 9 I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture.
 - a) John 1:1 (NKJV) 1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
2. Saved - *sōzō* - Deliver, protect, heal, preserve, make whole, rescue
 - a) John 1:3 (NKJV) - All things were made through Him, (the Word)
3. Pasture - *nōmē* - Field covered with grass for feeding; livelihood
 - a) 2 Peter 1:3-4 (NKJV) - Experience life through the promises

C. V42 - Phase 2 - Engage - Meeting

1. Engage - *Webster* - Entangle, interlock or mesh with
 - a) Proverbs 4:20 (NKJV) 20 My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings.
 - b) Hebrews 11:6 (NKJV) - Without faith it is impossible to please Him

D. V43 - Phase 3 - Encounter - Glory

1. Sanctified - *qâdôsh* - Sacred; set apart, dedicated to service and loyalty to God;
2. Glory - *kâbôd* - Weight; splendor, honor, majesty, abundance, manifestation of presence and power
 - a) Colossians 1:27 (NKJV) - Christ (the Word) in you, the hope of glory
3. Mark 5:25-34
 - a) V27 - Door - She heard about Jesus
 - b) V28 - Engage - She said, If only I may touch His clothes
 - (1) Shall be made well - *sōzō* - Deliver, protect, heal, preserve, make whole, rescue
 - c) V29 - Encounter - Immediately the fountain of blood dried, healed of affliction
 - (a) Affliction - *mastix* - A Roman whip for flogging criminals; fig. condition of suffering due to disease or plague
 - (2) V30 - Power had gone out of Him
 - (a) Power - *dunamis* - Miraculous force, ability, might; supernatural impact
