I. Ex 29:38 - PREPARING A DWELLING PLACE REQUIRES:

- A. 1st - OFFERING - We are to OFFER our whole hearts and lives in worship to Him!
- B. 2nd - SACRIFICE - The crucified life, losing our life to find life in Him
- C. 3rd - CONSISTENCY -
 - 1. Continually - *tâmîyd* - Constantly, regularly, perpetually (never stopping)

II. 1 Cor 15:57-58

- A. Victory - *nikõs* - To have conquered, triumph, successful ending of a struggle or military conquest
- B. Gives - *didõmi* - Bestow, commit, deliver to
 - 1. Webster - To grant, present, transfer; put into possession of another for their use
- C. Through - *dia* - Channel of an act, means by which, way it comes
 - 1. The relational connection more than what flows through the relational connection.
- D. **The key to our consistency is our connection with JESUS!** Our connection with Him allows us to do 3 things:
 - 1. Be Steadfast - Establish a position
 - a) Steadfast - *hědraiõs* - Being firmly established in one's position or opinions; unwavering
 - 2. Be Immovable - Hold that position
 - a) Immovable - *amětakingētõs* - Not shaken or moved from place to place; steady, unyielding, not surrender, relinquish or give up
 - (1) Mark 13:13 (NKJV) 13 And you will be hated by all for My name's sake. But he who endures to the end shall be saved.
 - (a) "Saved" is not just a one-time event - I have been saved, I am being saved and I will be saved.
 - (2) Hebrews 10:35–39
 - (a) Cast away - *apõballõ* - To give up and throw away
 - (b) Endurance - *hupõmõnē* - Cheerful constancy, patient continuance; capacity to continue to bear up under difficult circumstances
 - (c) Draws back - *hupõstěllõ* - To cower or shrink, to cease doing something of presumed positive value because of adverse circumstances or fear.
 - (d) The saving - *pěripõiēsis* - Protect something from loss or danger with the idea of maintaining possession as well.
 - (3) Hebrews 6:11–12
