I. Ex 29:42-46

A. 5 Phases of Dwelling with God (Abiding where He is):

1. Enter - The Door
2. Engage - The Meeting
3. Encounter - The Glory
4. Evacuate - The Consecrating
5. Endure - The Dwelling

B. V42 - Phase 1 - Enter - Through The Door

1. John 10:9 (NKJV) Jesus said, 9 *I am the door.*

C. V42 - Phase 2 - Engage - Meeting

1. We have to engage or meet Him at the Door (Word).
 - a) Proverbs 4:20 (NKJV) 20 My son, *give attention to my words;* Incline your ear to *my sayings.*

D. V43 - Phase 3 - Encounter - Glory

1. Sanctified - *qâdôsh* - Sacred; set apart, dedicated to service and loyalty to God;
2. Glory - *kâbôd* - Weight; splendor, honor, majesty, abundance, manifestation of presence and power
 - a) 1 Corinthians 3:16 (NKJV) 16 Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?
3. 2 Chron 5:11-14 - What happens when the Glory of God fills a container?
 - a) Levites were the singers and 120 priests sounding with trumpets
 - b) Filled - *mâlê'* - To make full or fill up in a container or a contained area
 - c) Ministering - *shârath* - To serve or attend to
 - d) Continue - *âmad* - To stand or be upright
4. 2 Chron 7:1-3
 - a) When the glory of God filled the container there was no room for impure things.
 - b) An encounter with God fills up space and pushes other things out.
5. Acts 1:4-8 (NKJV)
 - a) Receive - *lambanô* - To take, get hold of; to receive or accept an object or benefit for which the initiative rests with the giver, but the focus of attention in the transfer is upon the receiver
 - b) Power - *dunamis* - Force, miraculous ability, might, strength; Possession of controlling influence; the potentiality to exert force in performing some function
