I. Mark 9:14-29; Matt 17:14-21

- A. **Resolute** Marked by firm determination: resolved; bold, steady
- B. **Prayer and Fasting** -
 - 1. **Praying** Talking and listening to God, spending time with Him.
 - 2. **Fasting** Saying no to something in the natural more than you normally would in exchange for saying yes to something in the spiritual more than you normally would.
 - 3. <u>Job 23:12</u> 12 I have not departed from the commandment of His lips; I have treasured the words of His mouth More than my necessary food.

II. Mark 9:14-29 - Why could we not cast it out?

- A. <u>Matt 17:20-21</u> 20 So Jesus said to them, "Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you. 21 However, this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting."
- B. Prayer and Fasting causes us to experience things previously not experienced because we *SUPPRESS* us not because we *IMPRESS* God!

- A. <u>Disciples</u> <u>Mark 10:28-30</u>
 - 1. Matt 16:18 Gates are DEFENSIVE; Church is OFFENSIVE
 - 2. <u>Luke 8:28</u> Jesus did the tormenting
 - 3. **Ps 84:11** 11...No good thing will He withhold From those who walk uprightly.
- B. Hernan Cortes Spanish explorer to Mexico February 1519
- C. Rich Young Ruler Matt 19:16-22
 - 1. God asks us for everything because He loves us too much to ask for anything less.
 - 2. <u>Matt 10:38-39</u> Lose ourselves to find ourselves
 - 3. Clinging too tightly to what we have leaves no room for what God wants to give us.

D. Elisha - 1 Kings 19:19-21 - Living the "good" life

- 1. We get stuck living out other people's expectations.
- 2. When we are exposed to something greater we will drop something lesser.
- 3. He completely sold out of the plans of his father to buy into the plans of God.
- 4. The end of Elisha the farmer and the beginning of Elisha the prophet
