- I. Gen 1:1-3 Power of Your Sound It all started with a sound
  - A. <u>Heb 11:3</u> 3 By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible.
  - B. <u>3 things are needed for matter to exist</u> Scientist who started the Creation Research Institute
    - 1. <u>Nuclear forces</u> atomic particles through which everything around you is made; atoms, particle matter.
    - Gravitational forces Force that attracts any object with mass; Hold that matter or particles together.
    - 3. **Electromagnetic forces** Define the shape and the structure of that matter.

## C. Trinity in Creation:

- 1. V1 God the Father created particle matter out of nothing
  - a) Nuclear forces were present or atomic particles without form
- 2. <u>V2</u> Holy Spirit hovered over the face of the waters
  - a) **Hovered** (moved KJV) *rachaph* To brood, flutter or shake; a rapid back and forth vibratory motion.
- 3. V3 Jesus, the Word of God said, "Let there be light"
  - a) <u>John 1:1-5</u> 1 In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was in the beginning with God. 3 All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. 4 In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. 5 And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.

a) <u>Consist</u> - sunistao — to come into existence, with the implication of acquiring form and substance

## II. Power of Sound in affecting matter —

- A. **Quantum field theory** The cause of something is an equal or greater reality than the effect it creates.
- B. <u>String theory</u> At the center of all matter are tiny vibrating strands of energy called strings.
  - 1. Whatever sound they make determines the shape and structure of that matter.
  - 2. **Prov 18:21** 21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit.
    - a) Life to create or form; Death to destroy and to break
- C. <u>Frequency</u> number of waves passing through a point in a second creating a sound;
  measured in Hertz creating
- D. <u>Resonance</u> To prolongate or intensify a sound wave so that it can be heard or detected; re-sound.
- E. <u>Entrainment</u> If two things are on the same frequency then they will interact together.
  - Jer 1:9-10 9 Then the LORD put forth His hand and toughed my mouth, and the LORD said to me: "Behold, I have put My words in your mouth. 10 See, I have this day set you over the nations and over the kingdoms, To root out and to pull down, To destroy and to throw down, To build and to plant."
