## l. <u>2 Chron 5:11-14</u>

- A. <u>V12</u> Instruments
  - 1. Cymbals Percussion
  - 2. Stringed Instruments and Harps Strings
  - 3. <u>Trumpets</u> Wind
- B. <u>V13</u> <u>As one, One sound</u> *echad* United, to unify all together
  - 1. <u>United</u> involving working together to achieve something: people who share the same purpose, interest or goal.
    - a) Not divided Di-vision two visions/directions/opinions
  - 2. Unity in Corporate Worship Group of People
    - a) <u>Ps 133:1-3</u> 1 Behold, how good and how pleasant it is For brethren to dwell together in unity! 2 It is like the precious oil upon the head, Running down on the beard, The beard of Aaron, Running down on the edge of his garments. 3 It is like the dew of Hermon, Descending upon the mountains of Zion; For there the Lord commanded the blessing — Life forevermore.

## 3. Unity in Personal Worship - Spirit, Soul and Body

- a) **Ps 42:5** 5 Why are you cast down, O my soul? And why are you disquieted within me? Hope in God, for I shall yet praise Him For the help of His countenance.
- 4. **To make one sound to be heard** not the SAME sound
  - a) **Sound** *qowl* To call aloud, a voice or sound produced by the vocal cords.
- C. <u>V13-14</u> What was the result? Vertical and Horizontal response
  - 1. <u>Vertical response</u> House of the LORD filled with the cloud the glory
  - 2. What is the House of the LORD?
    - a) Individual
    - b) Home
    - c) Church
  - 3. <u>**Glory**</u> *kabowd* Great physical weight or quantity of a thing, splendor, abundance, honor

- 4. <u>**Glory**</u> *doxa* manifestation of power, splendid, remarkable appearance, great, wonderful, etc.
  - a) Wonder, splendor, majesty of who He is. The totality of all that He is!
- 5. <u>Acts 2:1</u> 1 When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. 2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. 3 Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them. 4 And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.
- D. 3 different types of His Presence Where does He live?
  - 1. **Omnipresence of God** God is everywhere,
    - a) Ps 139:7
  - 2. Inner Presence of God When He comes to live on the inside of you
    - a) Rom 8:9-11
    - b) 1 Cor 3:16
  - 3. Manifest Presence of God Makes His presence known among us.
    - a) **<u>Gen 3:8</u>** 8 And they heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God among the trees of the garden.
    - b) <u>Ex 33:14-15</u> 14 And He said, "My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest." 15 Then he said to Him, "If Your Presence does not go with us, do not bring us up from here.
